Government Guidance

Government guidance for funding: Schools should use this funding for specific activities to support their pupils to catch up for lost teaching over the previous months, in line with the guidance on curriculum expectations for the next academic year. Schools have the flexibility to spend their funding in the best way for their cohort and circumstances. To support schools to implement their catch-up plans effectively, EEF has published the school planning guide: 2020 to 2021. Although you'll receive funding on a per pupil basis, you should use the sum available to you as a single total to prioritise support. There are no specific requirements for who to spend it on.
