Due to the Lockdown and not all children being in school we had a Zoom meeting at 12.45pm to discuss Online Safety during home learning.

Area discussed	Actions to be taken (who/by when)

Overview for this academic year: Autumn 1 Online Scenarios Autumn 2 Photos (sharing photos, giving permission, what to do if you see a photo you do not like etc.) Spring 1 Making the Internet a Better Place' Spring 2 Games and Apps Summer 1 Time Spent Online Summer 2 Strangers / Fake Profiles / Fake News	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our focus this half term is 'make the Internet a better place'. We spoke about this before we spoke about our questions for today. Everyone agreed that the Internet does make the world a better place as long as it's used safely.
Our first discussion was on the topic of Lockdown Learning. Do we think that children at Copp school are using the Internet safely during lockdown?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We all thought it was a safe environment as we use Class Dojo which is only used by Copp families. Leo suggested only using websites with green padlocks which means they're much safer. Lucy and Jasper spoke about out of class time children need to be careful on games (such as Roblox) that they do not add anyone they do not know in real life.
Our second question was 'What can we do to help make sure that everyone is safer?'	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teachers to make sure they test games and websites first to make sure they're safe. Teachers to watch the whole video first before sending it. Supervised / asking parents to check what sites children are using. Teaching children how to be safe (like the green padlock) and using apps like Kidstube as you can change the age rating manually.
Finally I asked 'Does anyone have any ideas for what the Online Safety Team could do in the future?'	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We can have meetings more often and put these ideas on Whole School Dojo so that everyone can see them. Games and Apps - Check which apps help with Online Safety and which are safe and which aren't. Make sure links are checked properly before sending them out.
