April 22<sup>nd</sup>-24<sup>th</sup></p>	<p><b>CURRICULUM OVERVIEW</b></p> <p><b>TERM</b> Summer 1</p> <p><b>Year 5</b></p>		<p><b>Art - Mixed media portraits</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials (for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay).</li> </ul>
<p><b>Science - Properties and Changes in materials (Summer 1 &amp; 2)</b></p> <p>Compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity (electrical and thermal), and response to magnets Know that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and describe how to recover a substance from a solution. Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating. Demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes.
