

Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 2 - Summer 2

I know the multiplication and division facts for the x3 tables.

By the end of the half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

$3 \times 0 = 0$

$0 \div 3 = 0$

$3 \times 1 = 3$

$3 \div 3 = 1$

$3 \times 2 = 6$

$6 \div 3 = 2$

$3 \times 3 = 9$

$9 \div 3 = 3$

$3 \times 4 = 12$

$12 \div 3 = 4$

$3 \times 5 = 15$

$15 \div 3 = 5$

$3 \times 6 = 18$

$18 \div 3 = 6$

$3 \times 7 = 21$

$21 \div 3 = 7$

$3 \times 8 = 24$

$24 \div 3 = 8$

$3 \times 9 = 27$

$27 \div 3 = 9$

$3 \times 10 = 30$

$30 \div 3 = 10$

$3 \times 11 = 33$

$33 \div 3 = 11$

$3 \times 12 = 36$

$36 \div 3 = 12$
